Kdg Spelling Words: it, bit, sit, his

1st Grade Spelling: me, tree, sea, be, keep, these, read, eat, street, feet, mean, please

1st Grade HFW: there, car, sure, maybe, don't, could, about, by

2nd Grade Spelling: night, kind, spy, child, light, find, right, high, wild, July, fry, sigh, by, why, behind, lightning

2nd Grade HFW: doing, sure, else, turned, studied, room, teacher, any, blue, carry

3rd Grade Spelling: age, space, change, jawbone, jacket, giant, pencil, circle, once, large, dance, jeans, bounce, huge, nice, place **Challenge:** excited, gigantic

4th Grade Spelling: glance, judge, damage, package, twice, stage, carriage, since, practice, marriage, baggage, office, message, bridge, chance, notice, ridge, manage, palace, bandage **Challenge:** fringe, average, fleece, fragrance, excellence



Here are some **Fun and Easy ways** to improve your child's fine motor skills. These activities build dexterity and muscles which are *absolutely necessary* for the ability to hold a pencil and write legibly (& pain-free.) You cannot give your child too much practice with these skills! Provide ways for them to

	Scribble/Color with Crayons	Do their own zippers, snaps, Velcro, laces
U	Do Mazes, Dot-to-Dot,	Set the table, Practice pouring water
	Explore with Play Dough, Kinetic Sand— provide tools like plastic knives and rolling pins	Play Board Games and Jenga, Slap-Jack, Uno, Hi-Ho! Cherry-O! Lite-Brite, Mancala, Connect Four
	Cut with Scissors—teach them how to move the paper with the non-cutting hand	String beads, Lacing cards
	Peel an Orange (and while they're at it, have them count the segments!)	Turn nuts on bolts, sort screws
	Open their own individually-wrapped snacks	Sort coins (and count them into their piggy bank!)
	Wipe up their own spills, Open and close lids	Tear paper and make a mosaic
	Do Jigsaw Puzzles	Play with Wind-up toys, Marble Runs, Chinese Checkers, or "paper flick" Football
	Make Cut-Out Cookies, frost and decorate	Paint with Q-Tips
	Use tongs, tweezers, eye droppers, clothespins, rubber bands, and turkey basters!	Pop Bubble Wrap!
	Build with blocks, Lego, magnet toys	<i>See if you can tie these in with talking to your child about colors, letters, shapes, and numbers!</i>
	Cut, chop, mix, spread with you in the kitchen
