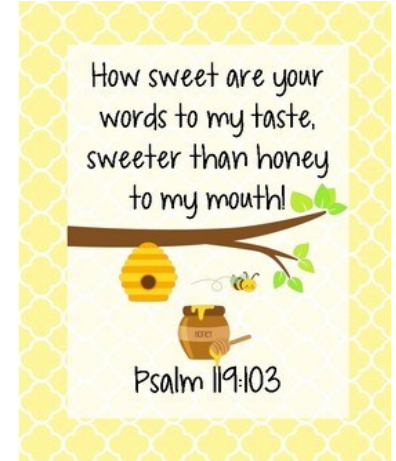
Sweet Words of Life!
