2nd Grade Spelling: own, most, soap, float, both, know, loan, goat, flow, loaf, throw, coach, so, grow

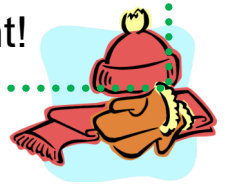
2nd Grade HFW: all, food, front, hair, never, party, sky, started, stories, warm
