2nd Grade HFW: air, car, cried, funny, he, pictures, pretty, told, try, window

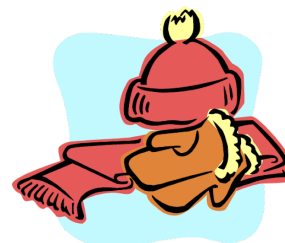
3rd Grade Spelling: three, scrap, street, spring, thrill, scream, strange, throw, string, scrape, spray, threw, strong, scratch, think, they
