Enrollment Process

- Call the school at (208) 326-5198 to schedule a visit and/or talk with us about enrolling your child.
- Complete an Enrollment Application and return it to us in person, by mail, or email.
Note: In order to enroll in Kindergarten Readiness, a child must be 4 by Sept. 1 of this year (2024) and toilet-trained (no pull-ups). For Kindergarten, a child must be 5 by Sept. 1. We regret that we cannot make exceptions to this rule.
- Remit the proper Registration Fee along with your application to reserve a place for your child.
- If your child is a new or transfer student, we will need a copy of his/her Birth Certificate and Immunization Record at your earliest convenience, but certainly by Registration Day in August. (Specific date TBA)
- All new enrollments are on a trial basis and may be re-evaluated at an agreed-upon time (by the school and your family) to make sure we are a good fit for your child. We just want to make sure we can meet his/her needs! If the class is full, we will place you on a waiting list and let you know as soon as we can if we can accommodate your child.
- If you are interested in applying for Tuition Assistance, mark your enrollment form accordingly, and we will mail you an application. Tuition assistance is available to qualifying families of children in Kindergarten through 5th grade.
