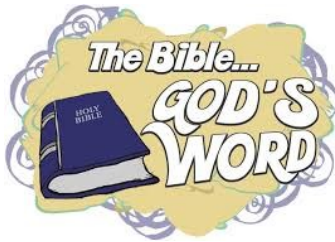

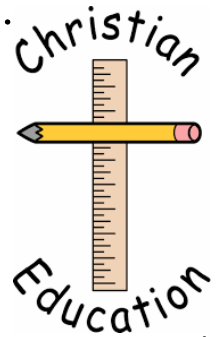


### Memory Verse for This Week:
