**Happy New Year**

As we begin school again after a long break, and as we near the beginning of the second half of the school year, we teachers want to let you know that the pace of most grade levels picks up at this point in the year. Information will come at the children faster, and they will need to use their *basic* skills of reading and math to keep up with the new ideas. You can help your child by:

- Returning them to a good schedule with plenty of sleep and nutritious food (in their lunches too)
- **READING** with them EVERY NIGHT!!
- Talking with them about things they observe and what they are learning about in school. Persist until you get answers! Children need to practice with information to help transfer it to long-term memory.
- Pouring into your child's "pool" of knowledge and experience. Almost everything children learn can connect with something *later* in their education to **FURTHER** their learning. Try to involve them in everyday tasks (ask them to help you compare prices at the grocery store) and have conversations with them about things they hear and see—whether out the window or on YouTube.

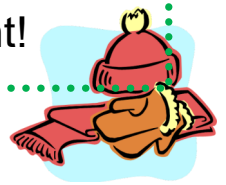
### **Upcoming Events:**
